



PURCHASE PROCESS

- 1. Purchase the card online at volunteercard.com/purchase.
- 2. Provide proof that you are volunteering. Forms of proof include an email from or correspondence with the volunteer organization.
- 3. Create a username and password on volunteercard.com/members to access your discounts.





Our online group tool makes it easy to purchase multiple cards at a discounted price (\$1 off per card). Group members are automatically approved because the organization is purchasing for the volunteers. All cards ordered using the groupt tool are mailed to the organization directly.

Not to worry, however. If you would like the cards mailed to separte addresses, we'll email you an order form that allows you to load the volunteers' contact information. Just complete the order form and return it via email.
